THE IFN CHILD SAFE COMMITMENT

I believe the caring for children is a universal responsibility and privilege.

I will ...

1. Care for children in my community according to their needs. I will not discriminate due to culture, ethnicity, gender, sexuality, faith or disability.
2. Never knowingly harm a child or allow them to be harmed.
3. Speak up and seek advice about the safety and wellbeing of children (including talking to teachers, the Executive Officer, Interfaith Network or legal authority).
4. Be a good role model for children, be polite and respectful around children.
5. Listen to, and value, what children and young people have to say, and include their voices in decision making.
6. Be a leader who stands up for the rights of children, advocates for their best interests.
